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2011-2012 Impact Statements:

- **Over a 200 children were inspired through JHCM Community Outreach programs at Jackson and Teton County family programs, festivals and events between May 2011 & the opening of JHCM doors on November 4th 2011.**
- *The Jackson Hole Children's Museum provides access to low-income and special needs families through it's, "Never say No" Family Membership & Scholarship Project.*
- *The JHCM Curious Kids programming, a daily Free explorative learning class, has thus far reached an average of 40 families per week, or 480 children since opening 3 months ago.*
- **Between August and December, the JHCM Education Team worked with 100 3rd-5th grade TCSD students through the Peak Program. Spending 5 hours a week in the classroom working with teachers and students on exploring Natural Intelligence through Art, Science and Literacy.**
- *The Jackson Hole Children's Museum has collaborated with more than 6 different local organizations to bring unique and thoughtful programming to area youth.*
- *In February, JHCM will begin its Curious Kids Afterschool Workshop program, again adding layers of play and learning to the Jackson's educational opportunities.*
- **Beginning in April, JHCM will officially launch the JHCM Diversity Pilot program. A partnership with the Latino Resource Center, Headstart, Teton Literacy, Teton Mentoring and Climb Wyoming, and others. The program is a collaboration of key organizations who bring education and access to area families and children who are at risk in some way. Looking universally at Accessibility, Cultural and Socio-economic Barriers. Participating families will act as museum and organization ambassadors to their peers, actively volunteer and take part in advisory council meeting to improve service and access points in our community.**
